

- 1. Partner with a school, daycare, church or another child-focused agency to raise awareness of child passenger safety by:
 - Leading a *discussion* of child passenger safety among staff and/or parents using talking points provided by Children's Trust followed by a car seat check.

OR

• Leading a *presentation* of child passenger safety among staff and/or parents using the PowerPoint provided by Children's Trust followed by a car seat check.

*If there are no technicians in the area to assist, you can reach out to Katrin Bost at <u>kbost@scchildren.org</u> for assistance. **It is required to offer a free car seat inspection following the discussion or presentation.**

<u>AND</u>

- 2. Have inspection station hours at least 2 hours per month starting March 2018 by conducting the following:
 - Promoting the inspection station, through 1) flyers at local elementary schools, daycares and churches, 2) social media posts 3) PSA on local radio and 4) other outlets.
 - Setting up the car seat check sign outside the inspection station
 - Partnering with DHEC by reaching out to Anne Stone at stoneas@dhec.sc.gov and registering with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

*If there are no technicians in the area to assist, you can schedule appointment times or reach out to Katrin Bost at <u>kbost@scchildren.org</u> for assistance.

- Survey Monkey evaluation report completed by **March 30, 2018 and June 30, 2018.**
- Updated contact information including email address, physical address and phone number.

- o Partner with local Safe Kids Coalition when available through Children's Trust

COMPENSATION:
