What is it?

The Triple P South Carolina (TPSC) Network is an affiliation of agencies and individuals who are invested in developing safe, stable, and nurturing relationships for all South Carolina families.

Member organizations and individuals are committed to preventing child abuse and neglect by strengthening and supporting families in their communities through the Positive Parenting Program (Triple P).

Why should you join?

As adults, we all play a role in ensuring the health and well-being of all children. Joining the TPSC Network gives you and your agency access to trainings, research and statistics, as well as a network of other professionals and citizens who are also committed to ensuring South Carolina is strong — every child, every family, every community.

Regular Membership runs annually (October 1-September 30). All memberships will expire on September 30 and MOAs will be sent at least 30 days prior to that to renew membership.

Requirements

Funded Children's Trust of South Carolina Triple P partners

- Children's Trust will verify practitioners are trained and accredited in Triple P
- Must sign MOU/MOA
- Required to use Children's Trust data system to show impact of Triple P across the state
- Required to attend learning collaboratives and Triple P practitioner summits for collective learning
- Must claim and keep information updated on scParents.org

Non-funded Children's Trust of South Carolina network participant

- Children's Trust will verify practitioners are trained and accredited in Triple P
- Must sign MOU/MOA
- Encouraged to share Triple P data to show impact of program across the state
