TRIPLE P IN SOUTH CAROLINA

With a generous grant from The Duke Endowment, Children's Trust is working to activate and support delivery of the Positive Parenting Program, known as Triple P, in three South Carolina counties: Georgetown, Greenville and Spartanburg.

In each county a funded partner works with an array of service delivery organizations who have been trained to deliver Triple P services. Service delivery organizations include pediatric practices, nonprofits, libraries, schools and churches.

With more than 35 years of ongoing research, Triple P is an effective, evidence-based parenting program. It offers simple, practical strategies to help parents build strong, healthy relationships, confidently manage their children's behavior and promote positive child development. Triple P has been shown to work across cultures, socio-economic groups and in many kinds of family structures.



Triple P South Carolina Practitioner Network

Children's Trust of South Carolina launched the Triple P South Carolina Practitioner Network to identify and connect Triple P practitioners throughout the state for shared learning, resource sharing and quarterly peer support.

Practitioner convening

35 Triple P practitioners and stakeholders from across South Carolina gathered to learn more about community-level implementation of Triple P in South Carolina, implementation support, national policy and program sustainability.

Newsletter

Children's Trust launched a quarterly newsletter for Triple P practitioners and stakeholders. Content includes year-to-date impact, upcoming activities as well as practitioner and caregiver stories.

Evaluation

Children's Trust updated the Triple P South Carolina evaluation processes, streamlining data collection to best ensure data-driven decision making.

Coaching

Children's Trust sponsored Champion Influence®, a 6-week skills coaching course led by master coach, business consultant, speaker, and author Toyinda Smith. Triple P coordinators from Georgetown, Greenville and Spartanburg and Children's Trust Triple P coaches attended.

Parent engagement

South Carolina practitioners came together for a peer learning session that focused on building strong parent engagement and population-based delivery considerations.
